

Eyewear compliant? There's more to safety eyewear than meets the eye

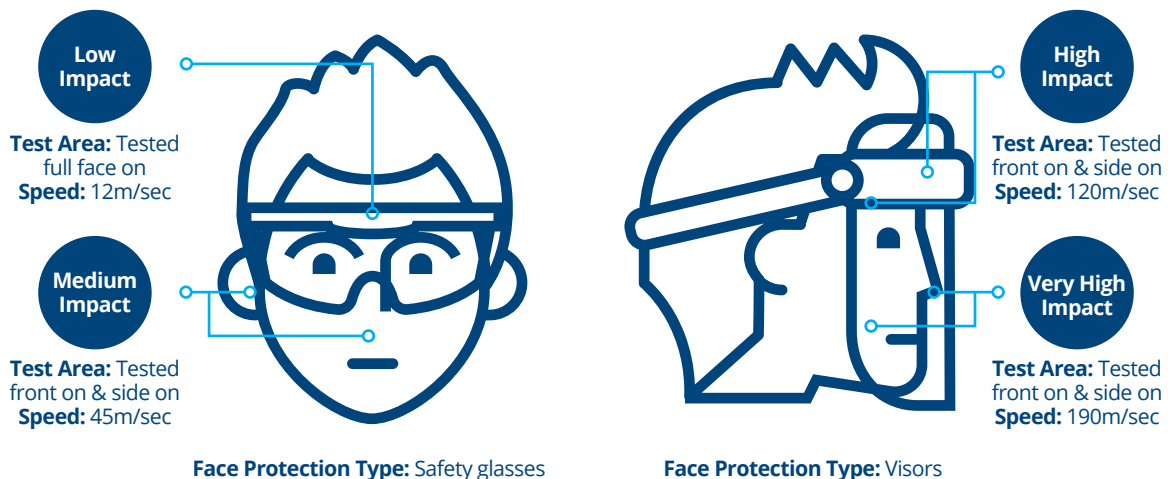
You can achieve peace of mind in providing the best eyewear protection for your workers by selecting AS/NZS 1337 compliant safety eyewear. The standard specifies the minimum requirements for eye protectors and associated lenses designed to protect the eyes of workers against common industrial hazards.

You can look out for the following independent certifies logos:



Rigorous Testing = Peace of mind

Compliant eyewear has been tested to endure the impact of a certain weighted ball without breaking, cracking, dislodging, detaching or making contact with the eye or head. The impact test is defined by the following 4 categories: **Impact, Test Area, Speed** and **Face Protection Type**.



Protector Marking Key = Making the right choice

Each frame and lens is marked to advise of its level of protection, the following key will help you to select compliant eyewear:

Type of Protection	Eye Protector Marking
Low Impact	S Optional
Medium Impact	I or F
High Impact	V or B
Very High Impact	A 'Mesh visor V or B'
Molten Meta	M or 9
Splash Proof	C or 3
Dustproof	D or 4
Gastight	G or 5
Outdoor use, untinted	O
Sun glare ocular	Category number 0-3
Photo-chromatic/transitional	Category number 1-3
High temperature	H
